He is currently a communications consultant and strategist at Brunswick Group LLC.

**Dana Evans** grew up on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. Trained by her father Starke Evans, Dana's serve and volley game style helped establish her as one of the best juniors in the nation. A graduate from Wake Forest University, she was recently inducted into the Wake Forest Hall of Fame. Dana has also had success on the Pro Circuit, and currently she is a controller of RW Restaurant Group and studying for her CPA.

**Paul Goldstein**, a Maryland native, has made an impact throughout his playing career. Paul was ranked among the top ten juniors in the world and then enjoyed a stellar collegiate career at Stanford with a 104-6 overall record. After moving into the world's top 200 in less than one year on the professional circuit, he advanced to become a US Open doubles semifinalist in 2005. Currently, Paul is the head coach of the Stanford Men's Tennis Team.

**Brian Gottfried**, a resident of Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida, enjoyed a phenomenal tennis career. He has won 14 national junior titles and was an All-American at Trinity University. He was a member of the U.S. Davis Cup team in 1976-78, '80 and '82, and climbed as high as No. 3 in the ATP rankings in 1977. Brian was also awarded the ATP Sportsmanship Award in 1984.

**Will Hamilton** started playing tennis at the age of five. He later was a member of the Division I Davidson College tennis team and, after graduation, coached at the world-renowned Junior Tennis Champions Center in College Park, Maryland. He is a PTR Certified Professional. Will is a co-founder of FuzzyYellowBalls.com, a successful tennis how-to website.

**Chip King** is an Elite Professional member of USPTA. He has served multiple terms as chairman on the USTA Mid-Atlantic Junior Competition Committee, and in 2012, he received the USTA/MAS President's Award for his dedication to improving junior tennis. He is an active volunteer with Mid-Atlantic and continues to play competitively in leagues. He is currently Director of Business Development for Bishop's Tennis.

**Stanley Pawlowski** was born in Long Island, New York. Stan was a nationally ranked junior and trained under the tutelage of Paul Annacone. Stan won many tournaments in his career including both National Hard Courts and Indoor Clay Courts. Currently, Stan is a Supervisory Special Agent for the United States Capitol Police's Dignitary Protection Division.

**Bobby Reynolds** was born in Cape Cod and played at Vanderbilt University for three seasons before turning pro. Bobby was the #1 ranked player in ITA at the end of his junior year. That was just the beginning of his incredible tennis career—it has been calculated that Bobby has played 1,954 professional matches including wins over John Isner and Marat Safin. Bobby teamed with Andy Roddick to win a doubles title in 2006.

**Graham Stilwell**, born in Denham, England, was an outstanding junior player. Graham enjoyed most of his tennis success while playing doubles, winning three doubles titles, two of which were in the Open Era. His best Grand Slam singles performance came as a qualifier in 1975, when he reached the Wimbledon fourth round. He currently coaches young tournament players at 4 Star Tennis Academy in Merrifield, Virginia.

**Dan Waldman** graduated *magna cum laude* from Harvard University where he was captain of the Harvard tennis team. Dan has been at the top of the tennis rankings throughout his junior, collegiate and adult competitive years. Dan is recently celebrating his singles and doubles tournament wins at the Over 60 Individual World Championships in France. He is currently a senior partner at the law firm of Arnold & Porter in Washington, DC.
